The full-time, 30-week program covers all the theory and practical components necessary for the first-year Automotive Service Technician Certificate, and provides a complement of valuable industry skills.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are the minimum admission requirements?

- English 10
- Foundations & Pre-Calculus Math 10 or Apprenticeship & Workplace Math 10

What are the costs?

- **Tuition** – A Dual Credit student’s tuition is fully paid by the School District.

Tools, Textbooks, Clothing and Supplies are paid by the student:

- **Tools** – The total cost of tools required for the Auto Service Technician Program is approximately \$1,670. There are a limited number of tool kits available at the NWCC Tool Crib. If available, the tool kits can be paid for at the time of registration.
- **Textbooks** – Approximately \$550.
- **Clothing/Supplies** – C.S.A. approved safety footwear (WorkSafeBC regulations), safety glasses and coveralls. Approximately \$250. Students are also required to provide: pencils, pens, eraser, three-ring binder, paper (lined & unlined) and gloves.

What are the dates and times this program runs?

Program runs during the fall and spring of 2017/18 (exact dates TBA) at the NWCC campus in Terrace. Application deadline is May 1, 2017.

The schedule for the Automotive Service Technician Foundation Program will follow the schedule of the Trades program at NWCC. The Coast Mountains School District calendar is not applicable to Trades students. Spring break, non-instructional and administrative days do not apply to the college schedule. The college will be closed for Christmas from December 18 to January 1, 2018.
