



## Trades & Transitions

**Are you currently in High School or a Recent Graduate  
and want to get a jump start on your future?**

### **Train in Trades (previously ACE IT)**

ACE IT is an industry training program for high school students.

Enrolling in one of these trades programs allows students to earn both secondary school and college credits.

- Level 1 technical training
- Tuition fees ARE paid by the school district.
- Texts and supplies are the student's responsibility.
- Programs are school-based or at Northwest Trades & Employment Training Center and Northwest Community College.

### **CE (Continuing Education)**

Continuing Education is a Dual Credit program offered to graduated students. To be eligible for funding, the student must not turn 19 before July 1st of the year in which the program begins. Please consult your school career counsellor for available programs.

### **Work in Trades (previously SSA)**

Earn money while you earn school credits. You can choose to work for a semester or part time during the school year and summer and earn up to 16 high school credits. For each 120 hours you will earn 4 credits and a significant head start towards completing an apprenticeship.

Students who complete the program and satisfy all the criteria **will earn a \$1,000 scholarship.**

### **How to get started:**

1. Select a trade/industry that interests you and learn as much about it as you can.
2. Try a Work Experience placement in the trade.
3. Find an employer that will hire you and commit to your training.
4. Earn while you learn! **(See reverse for list of Trades Programs offered at CMSD82.)**

Once you sign up as an apprentice, you will be registered with the Industry Training Authority (ITA) and receive an identification number that will be used throughout your trades career.
