



DUAL CREDIT – ESTHETICS PROGRAM – SMITHERS FEBRUARY TO AUGUST 2019

As a student in the NWCC Esthetics Program you will learn the latest industry techniques for a wide range of treatments through the Pivot Point Curriculum. Students will cover topics such as skin care, facials, hair removal, make-up design, face and body treatments, and massage. Students also learn about the salon business, professional development and personal development.

This is an 800-hour program that combines the theoretical and practical Esthetics skills – with 300 classroom hours and 500 practical salon hours. Students will be prepared to write the *BC Beauty Council* exam upon completion of the program.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are the minimum admission requirements?

- English 10
- Foundations & Pre-Calculus Math 10 or Apprenticeship & Workplace Math 10

What are the costs?

- **Tuition** – A Dual Credit student’s tuition is fully paid by the School District.

Students will be required to purchase student kits and books.

- **Textbooks** – Approx. \$300
- **Supply & Tool Kit** – Approx. \$1,400

What are the dates this program runs?

The program runs from February 4 to August 2, 2019 at NWCC in Smithers. Application deadline is May 31, 2018.

The schedule for the Esthetics program will follow the schedule of the Northwest Community College. The Coast Mountains School District calendar is not applicable to the Esthetics students. Spring break, non-instructional days and administrative days do not apply to the college schedule. NWCC is closed for Christmas from December 17, 2018 to January 1, 2019.
