#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

##### What are the minimum admission requirements?

- English 10
- Foundations & Pre-Calculus Math 10 or Apprenticeship & Workplace Math 10

##### What are the costs?

- **Tuition** – A Dual Credit student's tuition is fully paid by the School District.

##### Supplies and books are paid by the student

- **Textbooks** - approx. \$945.
- **Kit** – approx. \$930.

##### What are the dates and times this program runs?

- This program runs from September 4, 2018 to July 12, 2019, at the Northwest Trades & Employment Training Centre in Thornhill. Application deadline is May 31, 2018.
- The schedule for the Hairdressing program will follow the schedule of the Northwest Community College. The Coast Mountains School District calendar is not applicable to the Hairdressing students. Spring break, non-instructional days and administrative days do not apply to the college schedule. NWCC is closed for Christmas from December 17, 2018 to January 1, 2019, and the Hairdressing program will include a one-week spring break in March 2019.
